The winner will take a step up in the Honda Racing Family with a Honda-supported ride in the European 250 championship in 2018.

As members of the Honda Racing Family in the World Motocross paddock, the aspiring youth riders will have invaluable access to workshops hosted by partners, sponsors and some of Honda's MXGP stars.
