## Motocross of European Nations to be held in Poland in 2017

Youthstream is pleased to announce that the Motocross of European Nations and the Women's Motocross of European Nations will be back on the calendar in 2017 with the event set to take place on the weekend of September 3rd in Poland. The event will be held at the circuit of Gdansk, on the same track that hosted the 2005 edition.
