## FIM Europe 2<sup>nd</sup> Workshop on Leadership

FIM Europe will organize the 2<sup>nd</sup> Workshop on Leadership, addressed to the leaders of the FMNs Executive Staff: the Secretaries General. After the first, successful, edition, which took place in Maggiora (Italy), in November 2013, the second Workshop will be held in two sessions in Jerez de la Frontera (Spain) on 27-29 March and on 22-24 November 2015.

In fact, thanks to the FIM appointment of Jerez as World Capital of Motorcycling, the Municipality of Jerez has granted the opportunity to organize this important workshop without costs for the FIM Europe and the participants of its FMNs. The Workshop will be held by Sadhana Singh Avenali, International Lead Trainer of L&MKYT, a company that deals with the training method "Kundalini Yoga".
