#### Agreements administered by WP.29


The World Forum administers 3 Agreements:

<u>'58 Agreement</u> concerning the adoption of uniform technical prescriptions for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles and the conditions for *reciprocal recognition* of approvals granted on the basis of these prescriptions (54 Contracting Parties, 142 UNECE Regulations)


'98 Agreement concerning the establishing of global technical regulations (gtrs) for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicle (35 Contracting Parties, 18 gtrs, adopted in 2012)

'97 Agreement concerning the adoption of uniform conditions for periodical technical inspections of wheeled vehicles and the reciprocal recognition of such inspections (14 Contracting Parties, 17 pending signatories,)

The 58 & 98 should have similar technical provisions (parallel)

## Italy in Figures

- ► Motorcycle Fleet: 6,5 milion
- ► New Motorcycle Registered in 2016: ≅ 200,000
- In 2014 there was about 3,400 fatalities due to road accidents namely:
  - 273 cycles
  - 578 pedestrians
  - 816 motorcycles/mopeds
  - 1491 cars

## Road Safety Figures

- According to some national studies (USA, Europe, Japan) accidents involving motorcycles:
- ▶ 50-70% are caused by other vehicles;
- ▶ 60-90% the collision is with a car;
- ▶ 15-30% the collision occured at junctions

#### What Have We Done in UNECE?

- Amendment to the 1968 Vienna Conventions to address the challenges related to automated driving- entered into force
- Worked on vehicle automation such as "self steering vehicles" and "Remote Control Parking" and adopted first proposals on Corrective Steering Functions and Automatically Commanded Steering Functions (UN ECE Reg. 79)
- Guidelines on Cyber Security and Data Protection

Draft Regulation on Driver Assist Systems to Avoid Blind Spot Accidents


► It is aiming to introduce Blind Spot Information System on Heavy Duty Vehicle
