### Reimbursement

The organizer can procure an accommodation for every participating team.

This also includes breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Teams that want to take advantage of this offer have to pay an additional fee of 40 € per person per night when registering the team.

Insofar as nations pay an allowance of 40 euros per day and per person of the delegation, the choice is left to the discretion of the different countries to either bring forward the arrival date at the same time as the seniors and/or extend it at the end of the championship to include the night from Saturday to Sunday and breakfast.



**The country must before 5th mai send the organiser the number of participants and the number of nights to be booked.**

**Payment must be made to the organizer before May 10, 2019**

**Warning : Without an answer by this date, the organiser will no longer be able to guarantee the accommodation.**

#### Participants

Teams from France, Lithuania, Russia, and Germany are allowed to participate in the competition.

#### Team compositions

Every national team consists of a maximum of 18 People.

1 Accountable person (Member of the international jury)

1 Teammanager (Coach)

2 Referees The presentation of at least 2 referees per nation is mandatory.

10 Players (Field and goalkeeper)

2 Mechanics

1 Doctor or physio therapist

1 Interpreter **french and/or english language**

For participating a player must be between 12 and 18 years old, including players that will be in this age-boundaries within the year of the championship.

Eligible to play are only players that have a valid FIM Europe license

Name of license : Motoball Continental Promotional one event

The permission from the players national Association must be granted.

All players have to wear helmets in a matching color.

#### Fuel

Petrol will be provided by the organizer before the start of every game.

#### Registration

For registering a team, please use the enclosed form.

For participating the championship a team has to be registered until February 24th 2019.

#### Registration Deadline

(Teams that register too late, are not allowed to participate)

#### Number of motorcycles

Every team is allowed to use up to ten motorcycles each game, provided the motorcycles have passed the technical inspection before the start of the tournament.

#### Schedule

The organizer can adjust this schedule anytime, as long as a team has no 2 games directly after each other.

A game is played 3 x 15 Minutes.

The semi finals and the final game will be played 4 x 15 minutes.

The intermissions are 5 Minutes. Every team competes against every other team.

### Rating of the games

3 points for the winning team

1 point for both teams when they draw

0 points for the losing team

The standings will be determined by the addition of the points and the scored goals from every team.

If teams have the same amount of points, the placement will be determined by the following criteria:

1. The result of the 2 teams with the same amount of points
2. Difference between scored goals and goals scored against a team
3. Most scored goals
4. Penalty shootout with 4 field players of every team. 4 penalties are permitted per team.  
If the game is still draw, it will become a sudden death penalty shootout.
5. The semi finals will be played by the following concept:  
Semi final 1: 1st seed vs 4th seed  
Semi final 2: 2nd seed vs 3rd seed

The winners of both semi finals will play in the final game.

The losing teams will play the game for 3rd and 4th place.

### Awards

The FIM Europe provides medals for the first three places and a trophy for the European Champion. The 3 top placed teams will also be awarded with a trophy. Every participating team will be awarded with a participation medal. Those awards will be given to the teams after their last game of the tournament.
