### **Sweden & Vision Zero**

#### **Definition:**

INJURY REDUCEMENT


Survive crash violence without injuries in an accident at 50 km/h

MC & heavy traffic are not included in Vision Zero

Positive impact in attitude towards road safety amongst authorities and population

### **Challenges:**

Speed, alcohol, drugs and excluded groups like motorcycles




Death & injuries per 1.000, Cars & MC

# Systems to improve road safety for motorcyclists

#### Infrastructure

- Facts; Motorcycles have been completely overlooked in designing, planning, building, repairing and maintaining roads in Sweden
- A plan with 9 goals signed by the General Director of National Road Administration and General Secretary of SMC in the presence of the Infrastructure minister 2007





# The 9-point programme

- Collection of the 10 000 kilometer most popular mc-roads in Sweden
- Motorcycles also identified and reported problems on these roads
- MC-roads + accidents 2003-2007 on common maps







# The 9-point programme

- A common programme to improve the infrastructure on these roads, for example removal of gravel, signs, road work
- Include motorcycles in all guidance documents for planning, building, maintaining and repairing roads as of 2008.

# **SMC School – Advanced training**

+350 voluntary instructors, trained by SMC 200 occasions 2008, from three hours to four days;

**Basic**; for everyone or different riders like new on bikes, reborn bikers, ladies only.

Gocart track: Courses three hours – one day. Brake and curve course

**Racetracks:** Advanced Training and California Superbike School

- are for SMC members only








# The SMC Sportbike project

- New training scheme 4 levels




### Please remind...

#### The Rider











# **SMCs Sportbike project**

- MC friendly crash barrier for black spots and certain bends
- Usage of a more mc-friendly pole for crash barriers development!







# **SMC** campaigns over the years

- Compulsory helmet law
- Separate A-license for motorcycles
- Improved education for A-license
- Don't drink and drive
- Lock your bike
- The use of protection gear
- National laws for modification, rebuilding and building bikes
- Voluntary advanced training since 1973
