

FIM EUROPE BEACH CROSS EUROPEAN CUP

Art.1-LICENCES

Entries to the FIM Europe Beach Cross European Cup event will be accepted for riders who:

- a) are in possession of the appropriate Promotional Continental annual or oneevent, but it will be also accepted the Motocross Continental Annual licence.
- b) are authorised by their FMN
- c) have requested an entry before the closing date of the event

01.2.3 Age of Riders

FIM Europe Motocross European Championship licenses for riders are issued, only when the rider has attained the minimum age, as indicated below:

		Minimum Age	Maximum Age
-	MX 1	16 years	50
-	MX 2:	14 years	40 (see note below)
-	MX85	11 years	14
-	MX 125	13 years	17
-	Veteran (min. of 10 riders)	40	50

Note: - Applicants aged over 50 years must attach to their rider's license request a certificate of medical fitness (including a normal exercise tolerance electrocardiogram) issued by a doctor recognised by their FMN. The minimum age starts on the date of the rider's birthday and must be reached at the moment of the first technical verifications of the event in question. This is normally on the Friday of the event. The maximum age finishes at the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 14 for MX85, 17 for MX125 2 stroke, 40 for MX2, and in all other cases reaches the age of 50.

Art.6-TECHNICAL INSPECTIONS

1. After the preliminary operations for the technical inspections the bikes must be presented with no prior identification markings and with the assigned race number.

Art.7- FORMAT of THE EVENT (TWO DAYS) - Up to 40 Riders for categories For all classes:

first day

1X Free Practice 1X Pre-Qualifying Practice Free start practice Qualifying Race

second day

1X Warm -UP
RACE 1
RACE 2
Super Champ race

- **7. 2-**The race will be based on two final rounds, Race 1 and Race 2 for each group and for each category, the maximum number of Riders allowed at the starting gate will depend on its capacity.
- **8. 7.3-**All bikes must be in the Waiting Zone 10 minutes before the scheduled start of each race. After this period the Waiting Zone will be closed and will no longer be accessible. Therefore, late arrivals will result in exclusion from the race in question.

Art.8-FINAL INSPECTIONS

8.1-After each race the marking of the bikes of the first 3 Riders classified will be inspected, while after the last race the first 3 Riders of Race 1 and the first 3 Riders of Race 2 must remain in a closed waiting zone for 30 minutes available to the event officials in charge of the inspections.

Art.9-POINTS

9.1-Points will be assigned only to Riders who have completed at least 50% of the laps completed by the winner (rounded down).
