European U19 Pairs Speedway Championship:  
Latvian Gusts, Matjusunoks, Ansviesulis win the Final



The historic city of Gdańsk, Poland, hosted the first ever European U19 Pairs Speedway Championship Final.

In a thrilling and emotional afternoon, the Latvian Pair took the leading from the beginning. After an easy match with the Czech and German Pairs, it won 5:1 with pre-meeting favourites Polish and confirmed its hegemony in heat 11 with a double win over British. The British lost their comfortable lead over Polish in heat 13 after an own fall of Rowe but stayed focused on the result and collected points. After the Polish win 5:1 over Danish in heat 20 and a tie between Great Britain and Sweden in heat 21 the run-off decided on the second place in which Poland got the silver medal.

On the occasion of the World Environment Day and the Sustainable Week an autograph session was organized with riders, managers and Jury Member, signing a board "Join us create a better future".

**EMX 65 / EMX 85 European Championship: second round in Poland**

The second round of the EMX 65 / EMX 85 European Championship North East zone took place in Polish city Gdansk.

In the EMX85 first round ruler Janis Martins Reisulis from Latvia missed the race. Lithuanian rider Marius Adomaitis won race1 at the end of a hard-fought battle with Latvian young talent Markuss Ozolins (GasGas). Third position for Russian Semen Rybakov, who won the second heat although home rider Dawid Zaremba led for a long time. In race2 home rider Bartosz Jaworski finished second in front of Ozolins.

Overall results: 1. Semen Rybakov; 2. Markuss Ozolins; 3. Bartosz Jaworski.



In EMX65 class the Estonian Lucas Leok ruled both race1 and race2. In the first heat he won with a huge gap in front of his compatriot Enriko Peilman and Karl Teesalu from Estonia. In the second heat second place for Aliaksandr Frydlender from Belarus and third for Peilman.

Overall results: 1. Lucas Leok; 2. Enriko Peilman; 3. Aliaksandr Frydlender.
