8. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

Applications for entry must be made on the official entry form.

Applications must be approved by the rider's FMN and must reach the organizer before 19.09.2021 midnight. Applications after this date must pay € 100,00 extra entry fees per rider and can be refused. The organizer will select the applications and advice riders within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected.













Riders must be in possession of a valid One-Year or One-Event FIM-Europe Promo Sport license and an approval of their FMN.

FIM MiniGP Alpe Adria series riders must be in the possession of valid national license with starting permission from their FMN if necessary.

The entry fee for this EC Mini Road racing is € 250,00 per rider and per class.

The entry fee for FIM MiniGP Alpe Adria series is €200,00 per wild card rider. FIM MiniGP Alpe Adria entries must be sent to secretary.general@alpeadriamotorcycleunion.com

The amount for the paddock facilities incl. electricity, water (with toilets/showers) and waste (no tyres or oil) is included.

All entry fees must be paid via bank transfer within the registration date including name and class at the following:

There is no transponder rental fee.

9. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

The administrative checks will take place on

Thursday 23.09.2021 (Friday 24.09.2021 in case of two-day event) from 16:00 to 19:00 on the race-office building.

10. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

No rider or machine is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections. The official technical inspections will be held on Thursday 23.09.2021 (Friday 24.09.2021 in case of two-day event) from 16:00 to 19:00. During these inspections the helmet and clothing must be presented for inspection.

11. PRACTISING

It is strictly forbidden to ride machines on the circuit outside the official practice periods according to the official time table!

Private practices on previous days (organized by the circuit owner) are not part of this event.

There will be unofficial free practice during the week organized by the circuit owner – for Mini Bikes and Mini Moto classes.

Private practice schedule will be announced after the closing date 19.09.2021.

12. RIDERS BRIEFING

A compulsory briefing will be held on Thursday 23.09.2021 at 19:15 in the briefing room English speaking riders. All riders must be present and must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or team manager.

13. RACES: SCHEDULES AND DISTANCES

14. PRIZES

The final prize-giving ceremony will be held on Sunday 26.09.2021, immediately after the last race finishes at the podium.

15. PROTESTS

All protests must be made in accordance with the FIM Europe Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of € 350,00.

17. FUEL

There will be no fuel supplied by the organizer in the paddock.

18. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider (or passenger) is insured in accordance with the FIM Europe requirements and declares that the rider is able to compete in the respective class.

In conformity with Art. 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders and passengers covering accidents occurring during the event including practices will be the responsibility of the organizer.

This insurance includes a guarantee of € 170.000.

The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage to a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

19. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIM Europe Sporting Code, riders and passengers by participating, renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representatives or gents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Europe sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in Consequence of all acts or omissions on the part of the organizer, his officials, Representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or Arising out of their actions.



OBLIGATIONS AND LIABILITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FIM EUROPE SPORTING CODE

FIM Europe Sporting Code §60.3: BEHAVIOUR AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

The participant obliges himself to behave as a good sportsman and take no unsporting and/or fraudulent actions against the public, organisers, officials and FIM EUROPE or other participants. Violations of this article will be punished by the International Jury/Race Direction or the FIM EUROPE Disciplinary and Arbitration Bodies.

FIM Europe Sporting Code §60.6: LIABILITY OF THE SPORTING AUTHORITIES

The participant as per Article 60.2 in an official event exonerates the FIM, the FIM EUROPE, the FMNR, the organisers, the FIM EUROPE promoter(s) and the officials, their employees and officers and agents from any and all liability for any loss, damage or injury which he may incur in the course of an official event or the training therefore, subject always to Article 110.3 of the Sporting Code.

Furthermore, the participant undertakes to indemnify and hold harmless the FIM, the FIM EUROPE, the FMNR, the organisers, the FIM EUROPE promoter(s) and officials, the employees, officers and agents, from and against any and all liability to third parties for any loss, damage or injury for which he is jointly and severally liable.

Riders cannot hold each other mutually responsible for damages caused during the practice or race.

FIM Europe Sporting Code §110.3: LIABILITY FOR MATERIAL DAMAGES

Sending this Entry Form using a federation e-mail address

equals stamp and signature of the federation.

Neither the FIM EUROPE, nor the FMNR, nor the Organiser, nor the Promoter may be held responsible for any damage sustained by a racing or reserve motorcycle taking part in an official event or to its accessories or equipment during the event, however caused either by fire, accident or any other means, or by theft or deterioration. The organiser is however responsible for the motorcycles which are placed under his exclusive control (i.e. parc fermé). He is therefore bound to insure all motorcycles in this parc fermé for their total commercial value against theft, loss or damage during this period.

Riders cannot hold each other mutually responsible for material damages on machines caused during the practice or race.
