Supersport 300 Women's European Cup
FIM Europe's agreement with EMG Eventi and MotoXRacing MotoClub

On May 17th, at the General Secretariat in Fiumicino, an agreement with EMG Eventi and MotoXRacing MotoClub for the Supersport 300 Women's European Cup was signed.

The agreement extends until 2025 and provides for the title of Championship from 2023.
