

# OPEN EVENTS: WHICH LICENCE?

We would like to give you some supplementary information and clarify some points about the Open events.



1) National events entered exclusively to the **FIM International Calendar** (not to the FIM Europe Open Calendar): In this case, the **FIM licence** is compulsory. All the FIM licences issued via Extranet are “speaking” licences, having a QR Code printed upon that allow to check immediately the licence status and consequently if the rider is eligible or not.

2) National events entered exclusively to the **FIM Europe Open Calendar**: Riders must be holders of their **National licence + Starting permission**. Several times, these National licences are “speaking licences”, showing a QR Code, giving the possibilities to check in real time the status of the licence and therefore if the rider is eligible to participate.

When licences do not have a QR Code or when, for any reason, the relative link is not working should be used a **Rider declaration** and a consequent assumption of responsibility, with which he/she declares not to be suspended from the sporting activity.

3) National events entered both to the **FIM International Calendar and to the FIM Europe Open Calendar**: In this case, riders will be entitled to participate or with **FIM licence** (in this case remaining valid what mentioned at point 1) or with **National licence + starting permission** (in this case as mentioned at point 2).
